

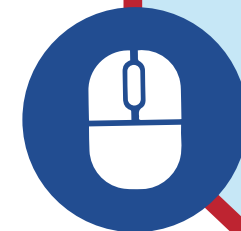
Validation of Formal, Non Formal and Informal Learning for Administration Personnel through Asynchronous Electronic Learning and Online Assessment

4th Newsletter, November 2024

The Project

e-EUPA – “Validation of Formal, Non Formal and Informal Learning for Administration Personnel through Asynchronous Electronic Learning and Online Assessment” aims to deliver state-of-the-art asynchronous e-learning for the development of the knowledge, skills and competences identified in the qualification framework developed by EUPA_NEXT, the project on which e-EUPA builds. It is a project co-funded by the European Union through the Erasmus+ programme.

e-EUPA will provide an alternative method for learning and certification for administration personnel on four different EQF levels.



Objectives

The objectives of e-EUPA are the following:

1. To develop a methodology based on key success factors for the conversion of traditional classroom training materials into asynchronous e-learning;
2. To use this methodology to convert all the methodological tools of the previous EUPA projects (EUPA and EUPA_Next);
3. To develop state-of-the-art lectures that are not merely Power-Points in PDF but streamed with the video recording of the trainers;
4. To develop a platform to get trained on different e-EUPA levels;
5. To develop online assessments certified with ISO17024 on four different levels for the learners that want to be certified on e-EUPA;
6. To train the trainers on the use of the asynchronous electronic learning method;
7. To sensitize the trainers on the importance of digitalization in education;
8. To support the VET providers in their internationalization, recognizing that asynchronous e-learning provides huge opportunities for international offerings in vocational training;
9. To provide the e-EUPA offering to commonly used languages of Europe, so as to ensure great impact of the project results.



e-EUPA Project Overview

The e-EUPA project offers an innovative approach to learning and certification for administrative personnel across four different EQF levels. By providing state-of-the-art asynchronous eLearning, e-EUPA helps develop the knowledge, skills, and competences outlined in a qualification framework created in a previous project. It also transforms traditional assessments into online formats, allowing professionals, students, and disadvantaged groups the flexibility to complete training and assessments at their own pace. Participants can also take assessments independently to validate their knowledge and earn certifications. Furthermore, as the education sector moves towards digitalization, e-EUPA aims to develop guidelines for converting training materials into effective asynchronous e-learning.

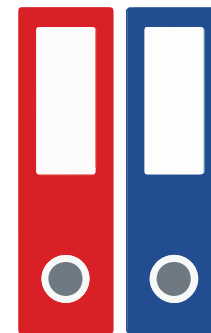
Final Transnational Project Meeting in Cyprus: (7-8 November)

The Final Transnational Project Meeting took place in Cyprus on 7-8 November, where partners reviewed the project's progress, with a particular focus on the Piloting and Assessment Phases. As part of this, the e-EUPA asynchronous learning materials, including PowerPoint presentations (PPTs) and multimedia tools (MTs), underwent minor refinements based on feedback. A sample MT intended for Moodle was showcased, demonstrating key improvements and gathering further input for enhancement.

Additionally, a workshop was held to fine-tune materials across various learning areas, while discussions also addressed the finalization of additional content, as well as strategies for dissemination and upcoming multiplier events. The meeting concluded with action items, next steps, and closing remarks.

6th Partners' Workshop (20 November)

During this online session, partners were provided with step-by-step instructions to pilot test the platform, tackling various scenarios they may have encountered. This hands-on workshop offered valuable insights and feedback to ensure the platform's functionality and user experience met the project's needs.



Updates and Work in Progress:

Pilot testing of the e-learning materials and the e-learning platform

The E-EUPA platform was designed to support asynchronous learning, enabling trainers and trainees to collaborate across different locations and time zones. Trainees can watch video-recorded lectures, access a variety of educational materials, complete complex assignments, and receive online feedback—either automatically or from trainers—all within a fully asynchronous environment.

Upcoming Activities

- Completion of the first stage of pilot testing with learners from consortium countries.
- Launch of the second stage of pilot testing with learners from non-consortium countries.
- Assessment of the platform using integrated evaluation forms.
- Promotion of the platform at the European level through social media awareness campaigns
