### E-EUPA: Final Transnational Project Meeting and 6<sup>th</sup> Partners' Workshop

Nicosia, Cyprus and Online

7-8<sup>th</sup> November, 2024 and 20<sup>th</sup> November, 2024

**The Final Transnational Project Meeting took place in Cyprus on 7-8<sup>th</sup> November, where partners discussed the project's progress, focusing on the Piloting and Assessment Phases. The review and finalization of the e-EUPA asynchronous learning materials, including PowerPoint presentations (PPTs) and multimedia tools (MTs) for the CORE UNITS, were completed.**



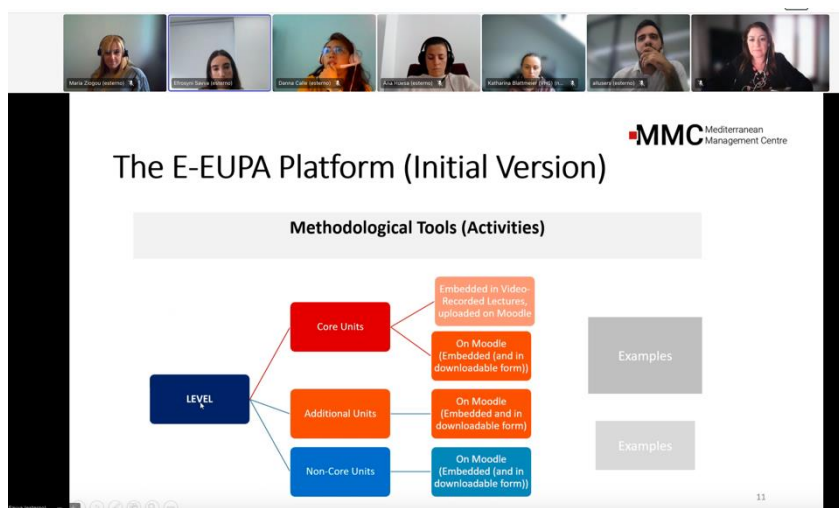
A good example of MTs to be uploaded on Moodle was shared, with feedback for improvement. A workshop was held to refine materials for other Core Units. The meeting also covered the finalization of materials for NON-CORE UNITS and planning for dissemination and multiplier events. The meeting concluded with action items, next steps, and closing remarks.



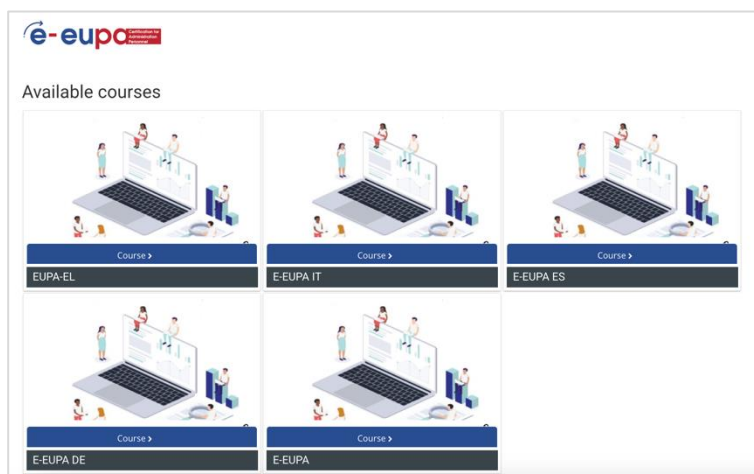
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Additionally, the 6<sup>th</sup> Partner Workshop was held on November 20<sup>th</sup>. During this online session, partners were given step-by-step instructions for testing the platform, addressing various scenarios they might encounter. This hands-on workshop offered valuable insights and feedback to ensure that the functionality and user experience of the platform met the needs of the project.



The **pilot testing** of the e-learning materials and the platform is currently underway.



The platform (<https://elearn-eupa.projectsgallery.eu>) was specifically developed to facilitate asynchronous learning, enabling both trainers and trainees to collaborate regardless of their location and time zone. Trainees have the opportunity to follow lectures, access a variety of materials, complete assignments, and receive feedback from their trainers in this flexible, asynchronous environment.

Looking ahead, there are several upcoming activities planned:

- The first stage of pilot testing involves learners selected by the project partners.
- This will be followed by a second stage of pilot testing with additional learners, again chosen by the partners.
- The platform will be evaluated using integrated evaluation forms to assess its effectiveness and areas for improvement.
- Finally, there will be a promotion of the platform at the European level, with social media campaigns aimed at raising awareness and encouraging wider engagement.
